Philippine Business Bank (PSE:PBB) will be releasing its earnings release today, May 6, 2026. Below are the key highlights of the earnings release.

Core income expands amid continued economic headwinds:

- Interest income reached ₱2,841.8 million in the first three months of 2026
- Net interest income grew ₱58.5 million to ₱1,884.2 million

- Other income expanded 13.0% YoY to ₱249.9 million
- Core income<sup>1</sup> at ₱952.3 million in 1Q26, up ₱57.0 million vs. 1Q25
- Net income ended at ₱221.6 million in the first quarter of 2026

Loans and deposits support balance sheet growth (1Q 2026 vs 1Q 2025):

- Total resources rose to ₱164.0 billion in 1Q26, up ₱3.2 billion
- Loans and other receivables at ₱125.7 billion, up ₱2.9 billion
- Total deposits increased by ₱3.4 billion to ₱134.4 billion in 1Q26
- Total equity grew ₱1.0 billion to ₱21.1 billion


